NOT NECESSARY TO FAX YOUR REPORT, but it IS REQUIRED WITHIN 24 HOURS


Per DHS 110.34(8).

A **Complete** patient care report must be available to the hospitals within 24 hours of patient care. The keyword is complete. Now that we are regularly auto posting to WARDS it is not necessary to fax the reports to the hospitals anymore. Just assure it is complete within the Dane Elite platform and they will be able to access it thru WARDS.


You will note in DHS 110.34 you are expected to leave some form of a preliminary report/summary at the hospital when you drop off your patient. This varies between departments, you can ask your supervisor for direction.

How to document a transfer to another agency – ie. Medflight


Incident/Patient Disposition - Choose Treated, Transferred Care to Another EMS Unit



Then Transferred To Agency ID will open, choose the agency you are transferring care to – ie. Medflight, ALS unit, etc..



If you know where the transferred to agency is headed, please enter that information into the Destination Info section under Destination/Transferred to, Name:
